

BANGLES



Outer diameter approx. 4½" [11.5cm], inner diameter approx. 2¼" [6cm]

Materials: Approx. 1 ball each (approx. 99yd/90m) of Lana Grossa Festa (76% cotton, 16% polyamide, 8% lurex) in khaki/silver (col 11), copper/silver (col 15) and mocha/silver (col 3); size J/10 [6mm] crochet hook.

Note: One 50g ball makes 2 bangles.

Note: Work with 2 strands of yarn held together throughout.

Post Stitches: Work in rounds. Begin each round with ch 2 (count as 1 dc/rf), join each round with a slip st.

Dc/rf: yo hook, insert hook from in front and from right to left around stem of stitch.

Gauge: 9 dc/rf and 8 rounds = 4" x 3½" [10 x 9 cm] with 2 strands of yarn held together.

Bangle: With yarn held double, ch 30 and join round with a slip st. Round 1: ch 3 (count as 1 dc), 1 dc in every ch = 30 sts. Round 2: ch 2 (count as 1 dc/rf), 1 dc/rf around every dc = 30 sts. Repeat round 2 six times more and piece measures 3½" [9 cm]. Fold piece in half with top of last row and foundation row meeting. Join edges with 1 round slip st, working under back loop only and working first slip st in 4th base ch. Post sts will run slightly diagonal to the left.
