

Napkin Rings

Size: Approx. 1½" [4cm] in diameter and 1¾" [4.5cm] wide

Materials: Approx. 1 ball (approx. 121yd/110m) of Lana Grossa **Divino Print** (75% cotton, 25% viscose) in beige/taupe (col 102) and approx. 1 ball each (approx. 121yd/110m) of Lana Grossa **Divino** (75% cotton, 25% viscose) in green/yellow (col 21), violet (col 28) and olive (col 12); size 7 [4.5mm] crochet hook. Matching sewing thread.

Note: Work with 2 strands of yarn held together throughout.

Single Crochet [sc] in rows: Begin each row with ch 1. Work first sc of every row in last sc of previous row.

Flowers, approx. 2¼" [5.5cm] in diameter: Work in rounds according to chart. Ch 5. Slip st in first ch to form a ring. Numbers on chart indicate beginning of rounds. Round 1: ch 2 (count as 1 sc), then sc and ch into ring as shown on chart. Join rounds with a slip st. Round 2: work into ch sp of previous round. Chart shows rounds in their entirety. Fasten off after round 2. Work foundation row and round 1 in one color and round 2 in a contrasting color. When changing colors, work st up to second to last step so that 2 loops remain on the hook, then use the new color to complete the st.

Gauge: 7 sc and 7.5 rows = 4" [10 cm] with yarn held double; 1 flower = approx. 2¼" [5.5cm] in diameter with yarn held double.

Napkin Rings [make 6]: With 2 strands of beige/taupe held together, ch 7 + ch 1. Work sc in rows, work first sc in 2nd ch from hook. Work 1 sc in each ch = 7 sts. Work in pattern as established until piece measures 4¾" [12cm] from beginning. Fasten off. Sew foundation row to last row to form a ring.

Finishing: With Divino in green/yellow, violet and olive, make 6 flowers as shown in photo. Sew flowers to napkin rings.

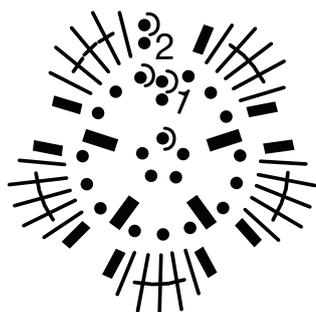


Chart key:
