

Colorblock Pullover in Eyelet Pattern

Size 36/38 (40/42, 44/46)

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

Materials: Approx. 200 (250, 300) g of Lana Grossa Puntino (100% mercerized cotton; 160m/50g) in Light Grey (col 60), approx. 150 (200, 250) g in Natural (col 8) and approx. 100 (150, 200) g in Grège (col 51); size 3.5 mm needles, size 3.25 mm crochet hook.

Eyelet pattern: Work according to chart. Number at right edge of chart indicates RS row; on all WS rows, purl all sts and yarn overs. Begin chart pattern with st before first arrow, work 5 sts between arrows for pattern repeat, end with sts after 2nd arrow. Chart shows 2 pattern repeats. Repeat rows 1 and 2 throughout.

Gauge: 23.5 sts and 28 rows = 10 x 10 cm in eyelet pattern.

Back: With Natural, cast on 107 (117, 127) sts. Next row = WS row: Purl. Next, work in eyelet pattern according to chart until back measures 32 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Change to Grège and continue for 17 cm, ending with a WS row. Change to Khaki, work remainder of back with Khaki and at same time, on first row worked with Khaki, shape armholes as following: Bind off 4 sts at beginning of next 2 rows, 3 sts at beginning of next 2 rows, 2 sts at beginning of next 2 rows and 1 st at beginning of next 2 rows = 87 (97, 107) sts. Continue until armhole measures 14 (15, 16) cm from beginning, ending with a WS row.

Shape neck: Bind off center 45 sts. Working each side separately, bind off 4 sts at each neck edge once and 3 sts every other row twice. When neck measures 3 cm from beginning, bind off remaining 11 (16, 21) sts for each shoulder.

Front: Work same as for back until armhole measures 9 (10, 11) cm from beginning, ending with a WS row.

Shape neck: Bind off center 15 sts. Working each side separately, bind off 5 sts at each neck edge every other row 3 times, 3 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st every other row 5 times. When front measures same length as back to shoulders, bind off remaining 11 (16, 21) sts for each shoulder.



Sleeves: With Light Grey, cast on 52 (57, 62) sts. Next row = WS row: Purl. Next, work in eyelet pattern according to chart until sleeve measures 12 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape sleeve: Increase 1 st at beginning and end of next RS row, then every following 10th row 7 times, then every following 8th row twice = 72 (77, 82) sts. Continue until sleeve measures 35 cm from first increase row, ending with a WS row.

Shape sleeve cap: Bind off 3 sts at beginning of next 2 rows, 2 sts at beginning of next 2 rows, 1 st at beginning of next 32 rows and 2 sts at beginning of next 4 rows. Bind off remaining 22 (27, 32) sts.

Finishing: Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew shoulder seams. With crochet hook, work 1 round single crochet and 1 round reverse single crochet [work single crochet from left to right] around neck edge. Sew in sleeves. Sew side and sleeve seams.
